

CFCCONTENT for display of LDAP images

Although broken in CFMX 6.0, the following code will work in CFMX 6.1 and up: This example demonstrates how to display images that are stored in LDAP when served from ColdFusion over CFCCONTENT.

name="content-disposition"
value="inline;
filename=someimage.jpg">
[cfcontent type="image/jpg" reset="yes">

Watch out for the formatting in the above code though. In the real code, even a space or carriage return between the CFCCONTENT and CFOUTPUT tag will break the functionality.
