Cocina tradicional de montaña. Especialidad: comida a la brasa, carnes, recau "Llanos", mondongo y adobo asados.

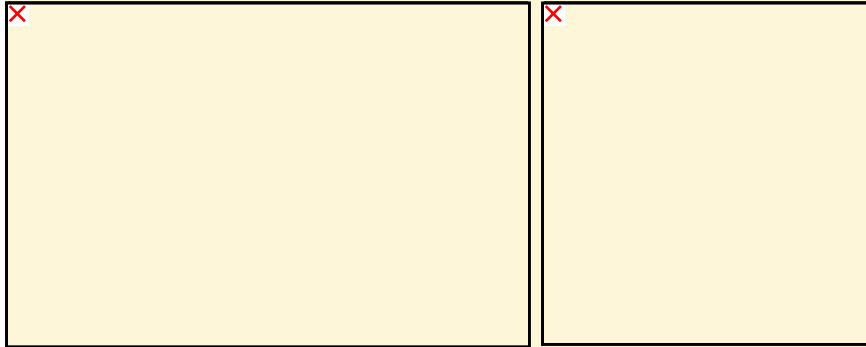
Abierto de 13:30 a 16 h. y de 20:30 a 22:30 h.
