A walk on the **Ruta HÃƒEpica**, an old road through the **Benasque Valley** of Spanish Pyrenees. This trail starts on El Camino del Sol near **Eresue** and passes along a north-western slope until it reaches Cerler, and ultimate **Llanos del Hospital**.

Before modern transportation this valley was relatively isolated and had its own language, Patues. Many locals still speak Patues and the valley is trying to preseve the language by continuing to teach it in schools.
